

Black Hat Executive Summit **Confidentiality Agreement FAQ**

- What is this FAQ document?
 - This is not a legal document, nor is it intended to provide legal guidance on what the Confidentiality Agreement is or is not.
 - This FAQ is intended to explain what we are trying to accomplish with the Confidentiality Agreement.
- Who will be signing this Confidentiality Agreement?
 - EVERYONE attending the Black Hat Executive Summit will sign the Confidentiality Agreement as he/she walks in the door.
 - Individuals refusing to sign will be turned away.
 - This document may be signed by an organization or an individual, provided that the individual has the right to discuss the confidential information he/she will be discussing at the Summit.
- Why can't we use a standard Non-Disclosure Agreement with Black Hat?
 - This agreement is not 'with Black Hat or UBM' but rather between all individuals attending the Summit.
- How do I know everyone will sign and honor this agreement?
 - This document will be signed upon arrival, name and signature verified with State or Federal identification.
- My company has a strict review process before I can sign. What if we have edits?
 - If there are oversights in the document, please email or call me directly. In the (unlikely) event of an update or edit, we will send a notification email to all registrants.
- If this agreement is with all individuals at the Executive Summit, how are we *all* going to sign this document?
 - As you check in, we will:
 - Verify your registration and entry approval
 - Your identity will be verified with State or Federal ID
 - You will sign your own signature page to the Agreement – making you a party to the Agreement
 - A wristband will be issued for expedient re-entry
